- What power do you believe Satan has in the world? In your life?
- What has God revealed to you about Jesus the Messiah? What do you believe God wants you to do with what you've been given?

- Write a thank you note to God that expresses your gratitude for all that God has done for you. Be as specific as you can possibly be.
- Consider deeply the implications of today's lesson upon your celebration of Christmas this year. Ask God to lead and guide you in your response.
