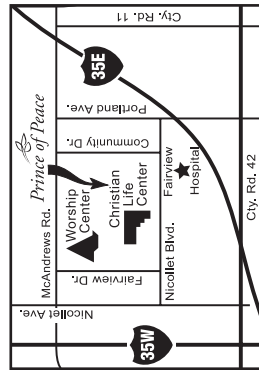
Spiritual Care Ministry Confidentiality Statement
